       **Registration**                      **8:30 – 9:00**  
Greet and register campers as they arrive each morning.

       **Information Table Position 8:45 – 5:00, 4 Hr. Shifts Available**  
The information table position requires a volunteer(s) to stay at designated table to answer questions about camp or to let parents know where children are in case of an emergency. A person with great communication skills and one who enjoys working with the public is ideal. Training can be provided.

       **Workshop Leader**                      **Various times**  
**Provide a lesson plan and list of supplies to teach workshops.** Lesson plans approved by camp directors. Please email [girlsrockindy@gmail.com](mailto:girlsrockindy@gmail.com) with your idea.

       **Workshop Assistant**                      **Various times**  
Help workshop leaders set up, distribute materials, supervise campers, and clean up at the end of workshops. Assistants are not required to instruct, but to generally help in the flow of the workshop.

Organize teaching materials, prepare handouts, and teach your instrument group.

**\_\_\_ Showcase Instrument Tech Saturday 2 pm – end of showcase**

Check instruments during sound check on Friday/Saturday and assist campers with tuning instruments backstage.

**\_\_\_ Showcase On-Stage Team Saturday 2 pm - end of showcase**

These positions will be on-stage during the campers' final showcase performance. Help usher camper bands on and off-stage, plugging in equipment, adjusting mic and cymbal stands, etc.

**\_\_\_ Graduation Organizers Friday 5:00 – 6:45**

Help organize graduation ceremony at the end of camp week, hand out t-shirts and diplomas, pizza and cake.
